Donor Levels

A campaign gift or pledge of \$1,000 or more supports our efforts to preserve Greenspace in Brentwood, including improvements at Smith Park.

Oak Hall Society - \$1,000-\$4,999 Gift

Donors who make a gift of \$1,000-\$4,999 are considered part of the Oak Hall Society. Recognition includes appropriate acknowledgement on a highly visible donor wall at Marcella Vivrette Smith Park in addition to invitations to donor events during our campaign.

Inglehame Society - Pledges of \$5,000 to \$9,999

Donors who pledge a gift of \$5,000-\$9,999, which can be fulfilled in annual installments over the course of up to five (5) years, are considered part of the Inglehame Society. Recognition includes enlarged

acknowledgement on a highly visible donor wall at Marcella Vivrette Smith Park plus:

- Invitations to donor events and gatherings during our campaign
- An invitation to a private tour of the park at a time designated by the City of Brentwood.

Ravenswood Society - Pledges of \$10,000 to \$29,999

Donors who make a pledge of \$10,000-\$29,999, which can be fulfilled in annual installments over the course of up to five (5) years, are considered part of the Ravenswood Society. Recognition includes top tier acknowledgement on a highly visible donor wall at Marcella Vivrette Smith Park plus:

- Invitations to donor events and gatherings during our campaign
- An invitation to a private tour of the park at a time designated by the City of Brentwood.
- Special invitation to a Brentwood City Commission meeting with recognition of their gift.

Sponsorship Opportunities at Marcella Vivrette Smith Park – Starting at \$30,000

A limited number of sponsorship opportunities remain within Smith Park. Donors who make a campaign pledge of \$30,000 or more, which can be fulfilled in annual installments over the course of up to five (5) years, will receive recognition within the park.
