Goal

Our goal is to create an outdoor experience to enhance the lives of the residents of Brentwood of all ages.

Key Benefits

- ▶ *Provides families and individuals in the community with a cross-generational recreational activity.*
- ▶ *Promotes healthy and active lifestyles in Brentwood.*
- ▶ *Value - provides a recreation benefit for a large demographic of the community for a very low cost and in a short time frame.*
- ▶ *Utilizes existing park infrastructure - Parking Lot & Bathroom.*
- ▶ *Maintains the natural beauty of park hillsides and tree canopy.*
- ▶ *Trail built to IMBA guidelines to protect the park's natural resources and create sustainable trails that require low maintenance and allow for uninterrupted use.*
- ▶ *Connects to existing greenway infrastructure for community access.*
- ▶ *Allows, Brentwood High, Brentwood Middle, Ravenwood, Woodland Middle, and Sunset Middle school mountain bike teams a local place to practice and train for regional events*



Community Service

We currently believe that we will have over 500 hours of community service when complete. We have been contacted by the boy scouts about doing eagle scout projects, mountain bike merit badge, community service, and trail building merit badges. We also have a lot of residents in our community that would like the opportunity to get their hands dirty and volunteer to help build this trail.

This is the nonprofit who will help us build the trail and has a one-million-dollar liability policy. They manage most of the mountain bike trails in middle Tennessee. By partnering with this organization, the trail will be volunteer maintained.

Our Ask

We have agreed to partner with the city on a public – private partnership. We are going to self-build the first 2.5 miles of trail and ask the city to be responsible for the remaining 4.5 miles in the back 50 acres. This would give us a total of 7 miles. We are asking for your help to make this project possible.



Donor Levels

A campaign gift or pledge of any amount supports our efforts to build the trail in Smith Park. All donations over \$1,000 will get their name on the current sign at the trail head, they will get their name or logo on the www.brentwoodmtb.com website, and will also get their name on the new sign that will be going up at the trailhead for the mountain bike trail. This is in partnership with Citizens for Brentwood Greenspace.

Oak Hall Society - \$1,000-\$4,999 Gift

Sponsorship Opportunities at Marcella Vivrette Smith Park – Starting at \$30,000

A limited number of sponsorship opportunities remain within Smith Park. Donors who make a campaign pledge of \$30,000 or more will receive recognition within the park. Ask for a schedule of locations for more details.

The Citizens for Brentwood Green Space is an IRS approved non-profit organization eligible for tax deductible contributions pursuant to Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3). Its tax identification number is 593774387. They are handling all donations for this historic project.

Cost and Timeline

Design: \$17,000 already paid from donations already received.

Trail Creation: \$180,000 - \$200,000 for 4.5 miles in the back 50 acres the City has approved to fund.

Trail Creation for the citizen build: \$60,000 for 2.5 miles and will be a hybrid build. A professional will do the hard work and volunteers will help with the finish work.

Timeline: 6 – 12 months.

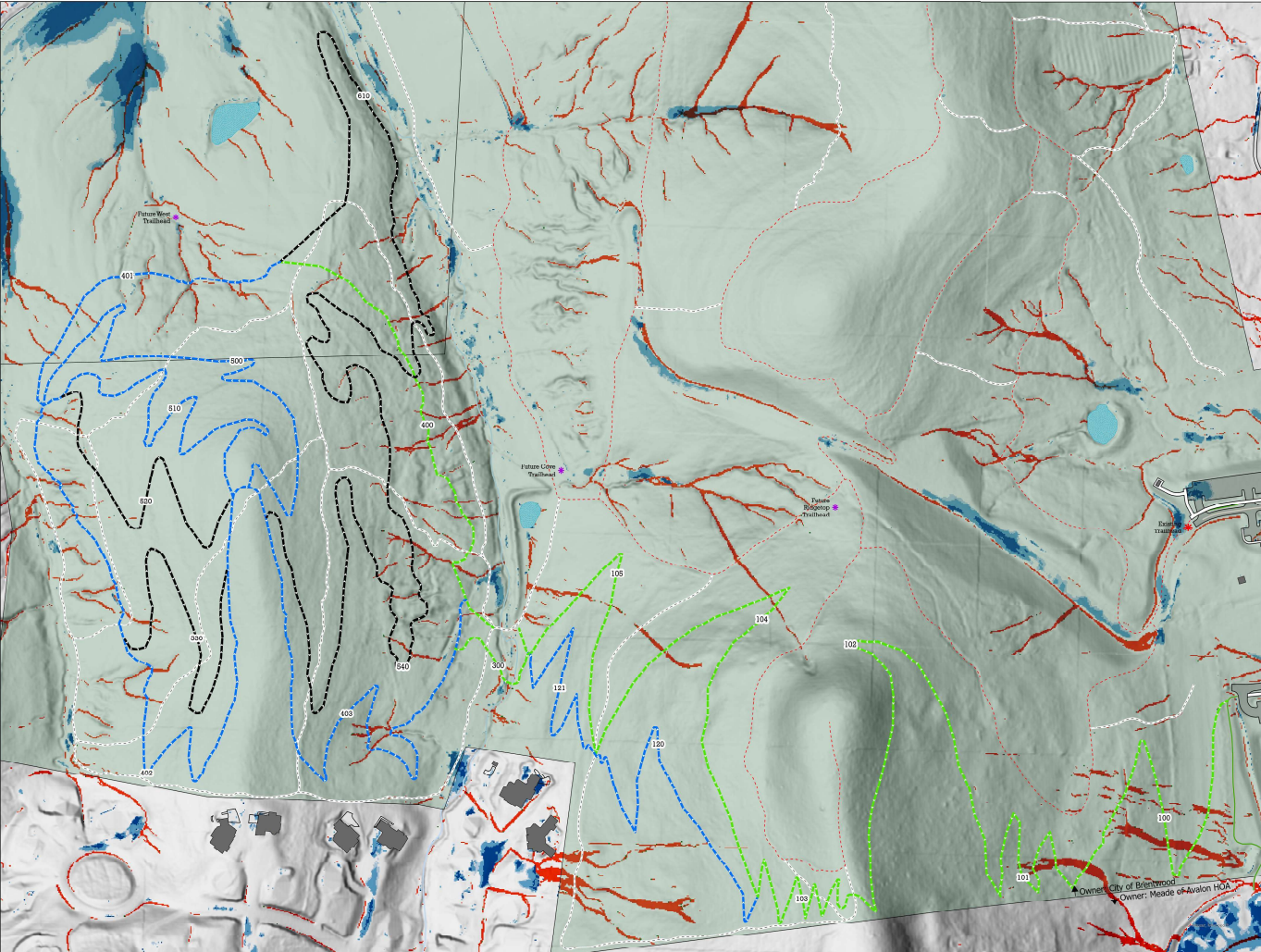
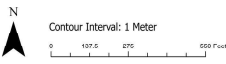
